## • SYSTEMATIC SUB-ATMOSPHERIC NEGATIVE PRESSURE WOUND THERAPY (SSNPWT)

Systematic Sub-Atmospheric Negative Pressure Wound Therapy is a technique that uses vacuum dressing to promote healing of both acute and chronic wounds. This method of wound management greatly helps to heal wounds that are complicated by burns, infections, poor circulation, artificial implants, or exposed bone.

SSNPWT aids healing by improving the rate of angiogenesis, endothelial proliferation, capillary blood flow, basement membrane integrity, and decreasing edema and bacterial burden within the wound.



## **MECHANISM OF ACTION**

Negative Pressure Wound Therapy (NPWT) promotes healing by evenly applying negative pressure on the surface of the wound. The system consists of a sponge, a semiocclusive barrier, and a fluid collection system. Its effectiveness is explained by four main mechanisms of action, including macrodeformation of the tissues, drainage of extracellular inflammatory fluids, stabilization of the environment of the wound, and microdeformation. Use of NPWT significantly reduces the therapy cost by reducing the treatment duration as the wound heals almost 68% faster.



- Bony fragments
- Non-compliant or combative behaviour
- Active bleeding or risk of bleeding
